CORRESPONDANCE GUIDELINES FOR KBI, FOR 2004-2005

A new correspondance program is starting 13 September 2004 for interested people who would like to take correspondance courses and live over fifty miles from the Center in which they want to enroll.

1. Finish one lesson each week and send work sheet back to the Center Director and write one page also telling what they thought was the most important part of the chapter.
2. Materials will be kept in the Center for those on Correspondance and send the grade to the President of KBI.
3. A person can take up to four lessons each Semester if permission is given by the Director Head. Only two years taken by Correspondance and the last year taking courses at the Center under an Instructor.
4. The final test will be an open book test that is supervised by their pastor or other individual he has assigned. Those giving the test will sign they have supervised the test and will mail it to the Center Director of KBI involved.
5. Cost is \$25.00 per credit and a \$10.00 enrollment fee each Semester. Checks made out to the United' Pentecostal Church, Kentucky District, and mailed to Center Director.
6. A Certificate will be given for each course completed and grades filed with the President of KBI and also kept at the Center.
7. At the completion of the three year period and all classes successfully completed a Degree will issued from the KENTUCKY BIBLE INSTITUTE.
8. All applications for courses will have to be signed by their pastor before they can enroll.
9. These directions are subject to be changed somewhat from Semester to Semester by the KBI Oversight Committee of the Ky. U.P.C.
