Special recognition goes to **Bro. Hendricks** and the saints of Greater Lighthouse Church in Madisonville for the top offering of \$2,000. **Bro. Knox** and the Grayson church gave \$1,540. **Bro. Marshall** and Russellville gave \$1,401, and **Bro. Anthony Keaton** and the Raceland Church contributed \$982.78! Seven churches gave at least \$500. and 10 gave \$200. or more. God bless each of you who gave any amount.

With the completion of this offering campaign, I take this opportunity to tell you that though I have emmensly enjoyed working with the Home Missions families of the Kentucky District, as well as the staff of HM, after much prayer and fasting I will step aside at our District Conference in April, and give another good man the opportunity to lead this departmant.
